

CO2 Laser Resurfacing and Deep Chemical Peels

PRE-PEEL REGIMEN (Begin 1 month prior to treatment)

Sheer or Tinted Physical Sunscreen
Hydroquinone 2% Pads
Retinol Serum

Each Morning x 4 weeks
Each Night x 3 weeks
Each Night x 3 weeks

Ultra Lite Moisturizer Each Day and as needed x 3 weeks

You will have facial redness, dryness, and mild peeling skin from this pre-peel regimen:
 Moisturize as needed

• Stop your pre-peel regimen 3-4 days prior to your treatment

TREATMENT DAY

• Please arrive with no make-up or contact lenses

• A topical numbing cream will be applied to your face for comfort

POST-PEEL REGIMEN (Begin day of treatment)

Bacitracin or Healing Ointment 3-4 Times per Day x5 days

Gentle Soothing Cleanser 3-4 Times per Day beginning day 1 post treatment
Sheer or Tinted Physical Sunscreen Each Morning beginning day 5 post treatment

ACTIVITIES

• The only activity permitted for the first 48 hours is walking, which you should do at least 3 times per day.

SKIN CARE

- Your face will be covered with ointment after the procedure.
- Beginning on the day following your treatment, cleanse your face with gentle cleanser 3-4 times daily to GENTLY wash the surface of your skin.
- Apply Bacitracin or Healing Ointment to your face 3-4 times daily or as needed beginning the evening of your treatment and continuing for the first week.
- Do not pick or peel at your skin! If you notice flaking or peeling skin, simply apply additional ointment.
- Apply sunscreen beginning on the 5th day after your treatment, and avoid sun exposure for 6 months.
- You may wear makeup after 7-10 days.
- Beginning at 4 weeks post-treatment, resume the Hydroquinone pads each evening, and apply moisturizer as needed.

APPEARANCE

- Swelling and "puffiness" is expected after your procedure, but the degree varies from patient to patient. Cold washcloth & ice compresses may be helpful to improve comfort. Swelling is worst on day 3.
- You will have facial redness and peeling skin that will not look "normal" for 6 weeks.
- You may feel tightness and pulling in your face for several weeks. This will slowly fade.
- You may experience temporary numbness along areas of the face, and itching along treated areas.
- Contact our office immediately should you develop any sudden pain, swelling, fever or redness.

FOLLOW-UP CARE

- Your first postoperative visit will be 3-5 days after your procedure.
- If desired, your second laser resurfacing treatment will be 3 months after the first treatment

WHEN TO CALL

- If you have increased blisters or ulcers
- If you have drainage.
- If you have severe or increased pain not relieved by medication.
- If you have any side effects to medications; such as, rash, nausea, headache, vomiting.
- If you have an oral temperature over 100.4 degrees.
